

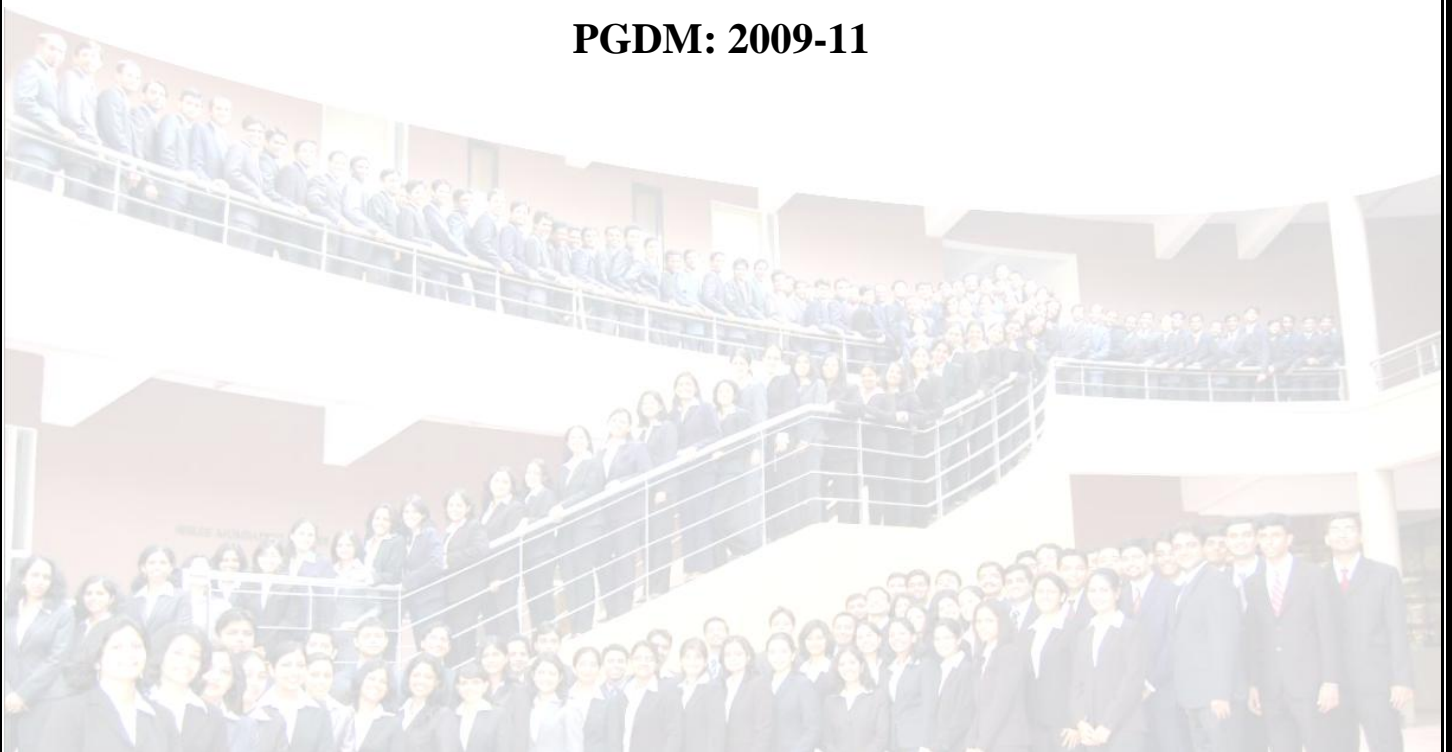

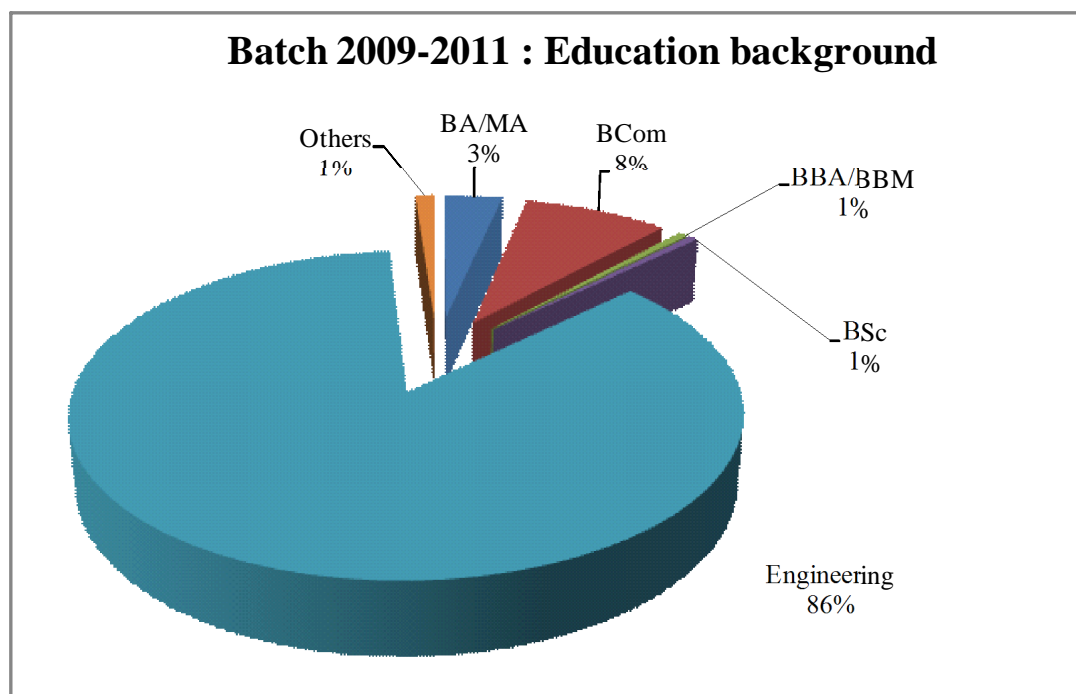
Batch- Gender composition
