FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE / AWARDS

Merit cum - Means Based Financial Assistance - The institute offers financial assistance to needy candidates based on assessment of need, academic performance, extra-curricular activities and conduct. A form will need to be completed and submitted to the PGDM office. Any financial assistance will be made available (subject to approval by the Panel after evaluation) only once the Programme commences and any adjustments /deductions will be post the student joining the Programme.

Merit Based Awards - Participants who are selected for International Exchange will be eligible (see below) for a scholarship towards meeting expenses as exchange participants in a partner B-School of international repute. The scholarship will be in the form of reimbursement for expenses related to return travel from India to the international B-School, visa and insurance fees and lodging during the course work. The scholarship amount will be based on actuals up to a limit of Rs. 2 lacs.

Participants will be offered an opportunity to take courses in our partner B-school of international repute as an exchange participant if:

- i. They are among the top ten participants based on the 'Admissions Merit List' in each of the four specialisations and
- ii. They maintain a rank within the Top - Thirty of the batch based on academic CGPA at the end of First year.

Participants ranked within the top 20 in the batch of 2018-20 based on academic CGPA (at the end of the first year of the Programme) will also be eligible for the exchange Programme.

Further guidelines to the selection process for International Outgoing Exchange will be circulated after commencement of Programme.

A Participant will be eligible for only one of the above finance assistance / award.
