

At Present, I am working as professor at S.P. Jain Institute of Management and Research, Mumbai. Prior to this:

(a) I was Professor and Dean (Academics) at Institute of Management Technology (IMT), Hyderabad. My responsibilities included, recruiting, developing and evaluating faculty resources student curriculum development and addressing issues in student development.

(b) I was Professor of Economics and Head of Department (HoD) of General Management at K J Somaiya Institute of Management Studies and Research (SIMSR). As a full time professor, I was engaged in teaching micro-economics, macro-economics, and international economics which are compulsory subjects for post graduate management students. In addition, I also teach financial market and institutions to management students with finance as a specialization subject. I was also course coordinator for Master of Management Studies (MMS) a post graduate course of Mumbai University offered in SIMSR. I was also engaged in training programmes for senior officers of National Thermal Power Corporation (NTPC), Hindustan Petroleum Corporation (HPCL), Maharashtra Electricity Regulation Commission (MERC), Tata Power etc. Apart from teaching, research and Management Development Programme (MDP) in SIMSR, I was also engaged in consultancy in various areas of macro-economic development and policy as a consultant economist in Axis bank, central office, Mumbai.

(c) I have also worked in the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) for about a quarter century. My last position in RBI was Adviser-in-Charge of External Sector, Government Finance, capital market and regional economics. In the external sector, the areas of work covered analysis of pattern and direction export and import, trade policy, overseas investment, compilation and analysis of Balance of Payments, capital flows and exchange rate, compilation and analysis of external debt and international investment position, policy level coordination with Institutions, like IMF, World Bank which include monitoring developments in the international monetary and financial system analysis of world economic outlook, and Global financial stability report, With regard to Government Finances, analysis of Central and State Government finances, Public debt management, contingent liability analysis, and liquidity position and market borrowing analysis were the main focus. Works relating to regional economics mainly include surveys and analysis on various regional level having implications for macro policy. Analysis of capital market development was also part of my experience.

I was also associated with the policy and operations of Government securities market, monetization of fiscal deficit, introduction of new instruments for Government borrowing, open market operation and repo, primary dealers and satellite dealers. Associated with the work relating to Reserve Bank of India's ways and means advances (WMA) to Government of India and State Governments, studies relating to limits on public debt and fiscal responsibility bill.

As Advisor to Governor Reserve Bank and part Indian delegation represented in the ,G-20 and International Monetary and Financial committee(IMFC) I participated in the meeting at IMF Washington,, Annual meeting of IMF. 2006 ,2007 and 2008. As resource person in BIS Working Group on capital flows I visited Bank of Paris, Bank of England, and Bank of Spain for the working group meeting in 2007 and 2008. I was Adviser to Governor, Reserve Bank of India in the 21st SEANZA Council of Governors' meeting at Beijing in October 1995.

(d) Before joining RBI I was teaching the graduate students as lecturer in Economics in the Education and youth services Department of Government of Orissa

I have publications both in national and international level journals. I have vast experience of drafting various reports of high policy importance. I have rich experience of involvement in a number of committees.
