

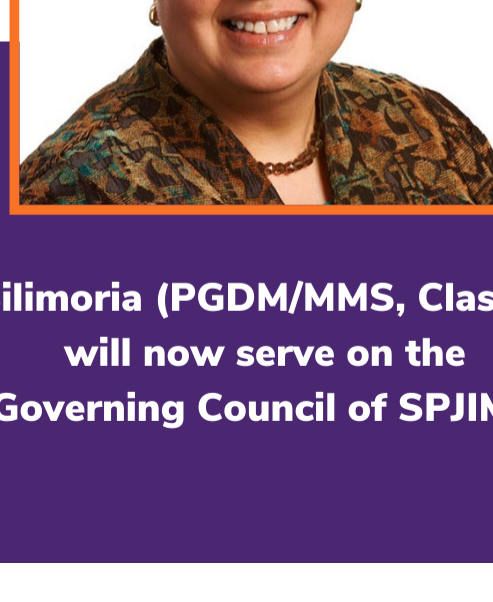

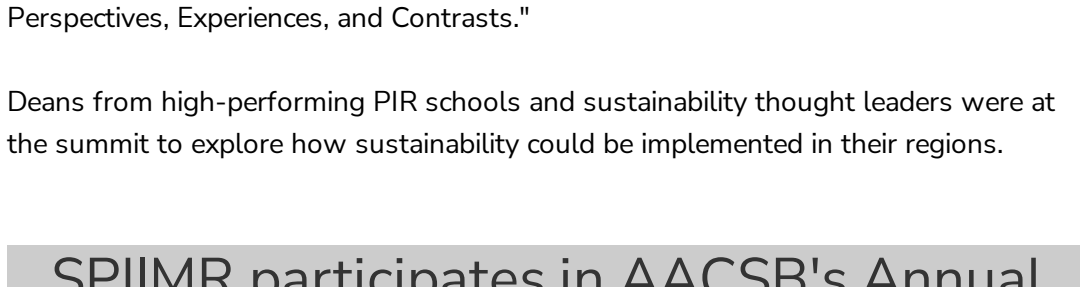

We were commended for our creative community-based initiatives, environmentally and socially conscious culture, and effective leadership education.

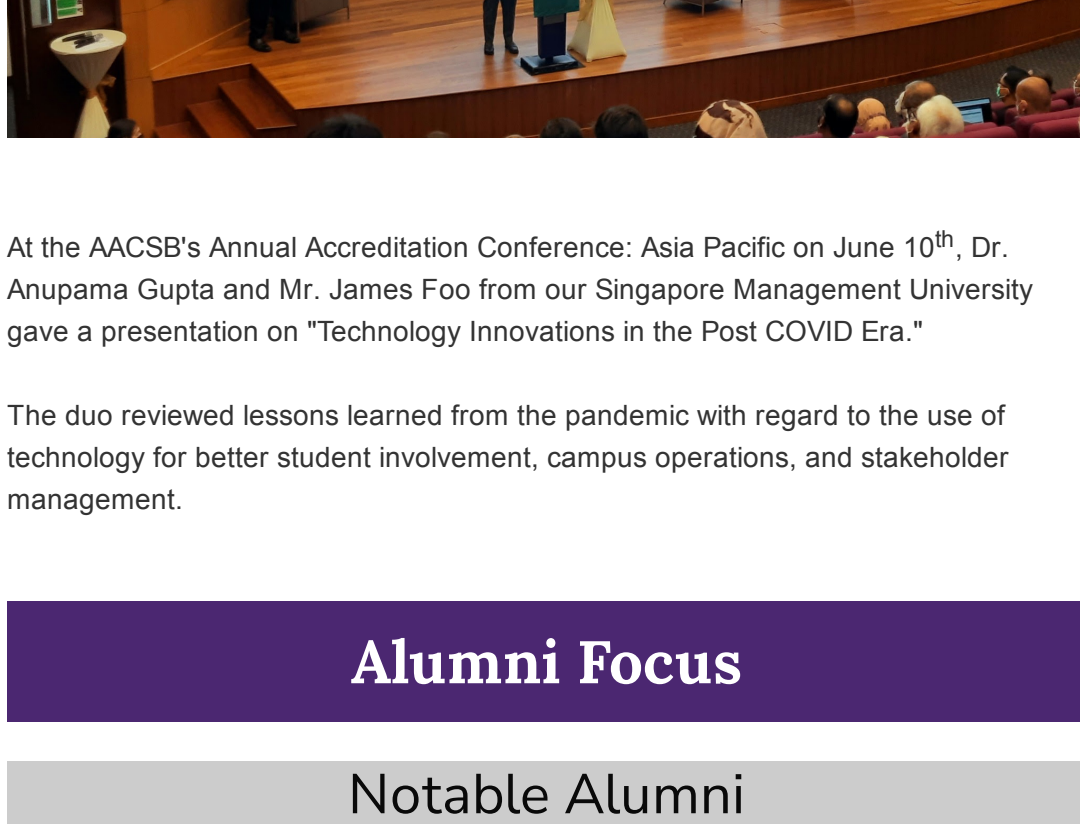
Dean speaks at the Global Deans Positive Impact Summit

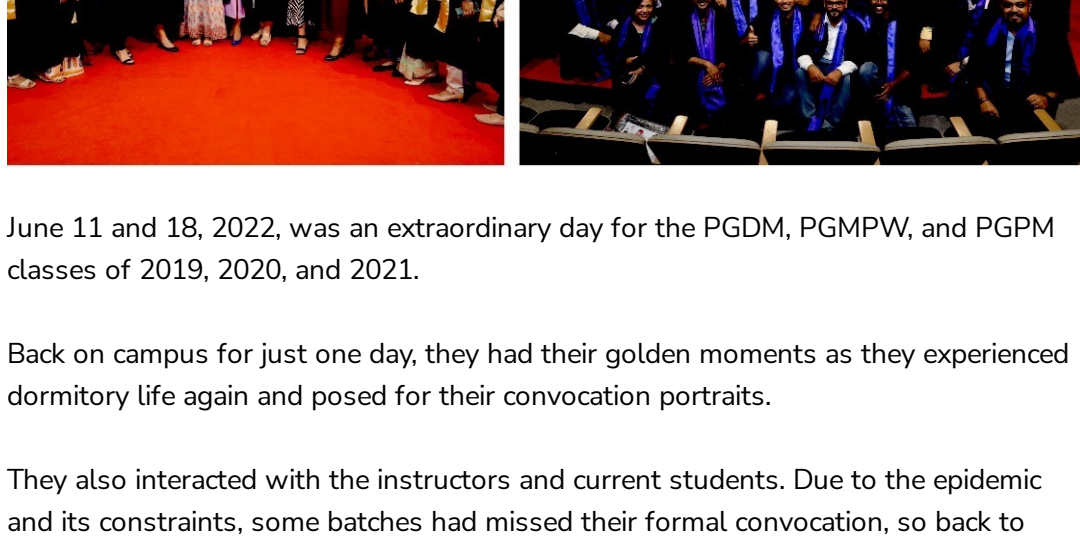

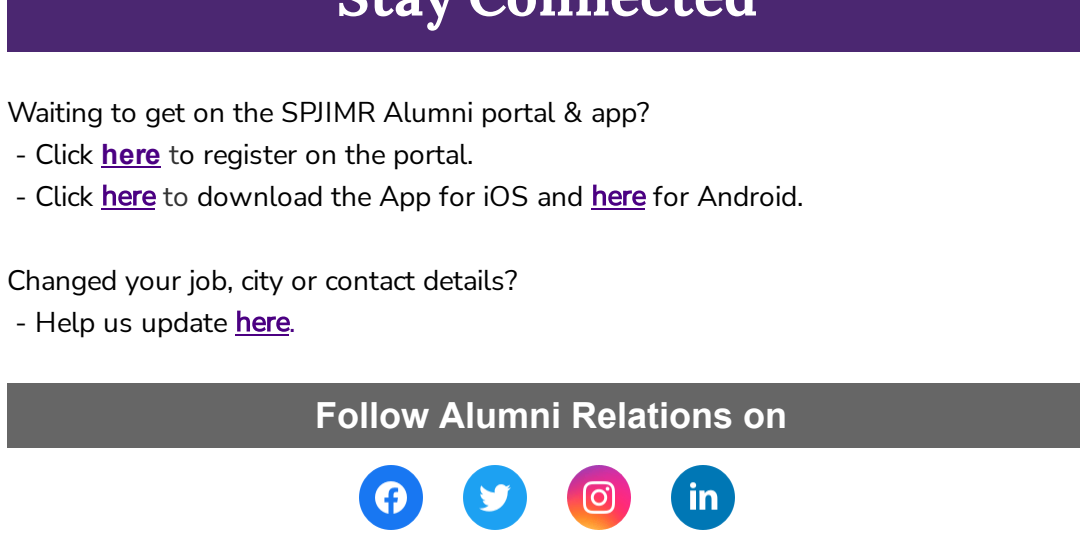
