



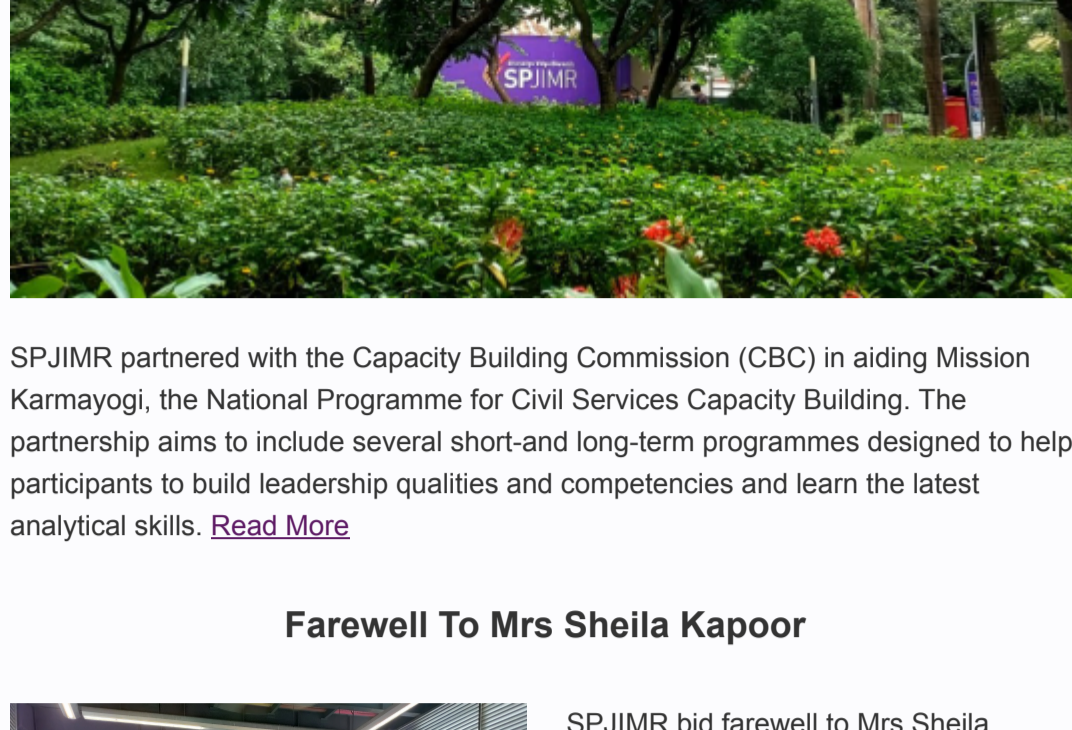

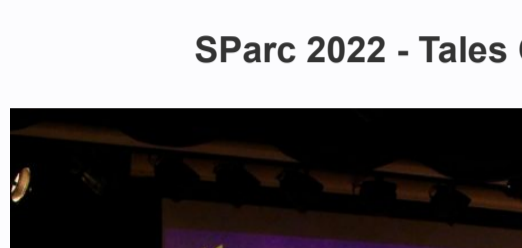

EP-BM Batch 2 Starts Its Journey Of Learning



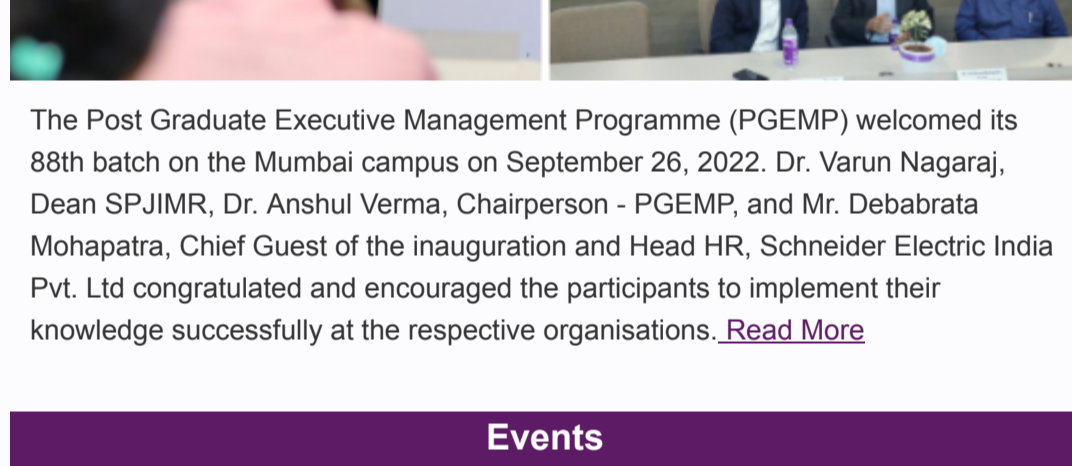

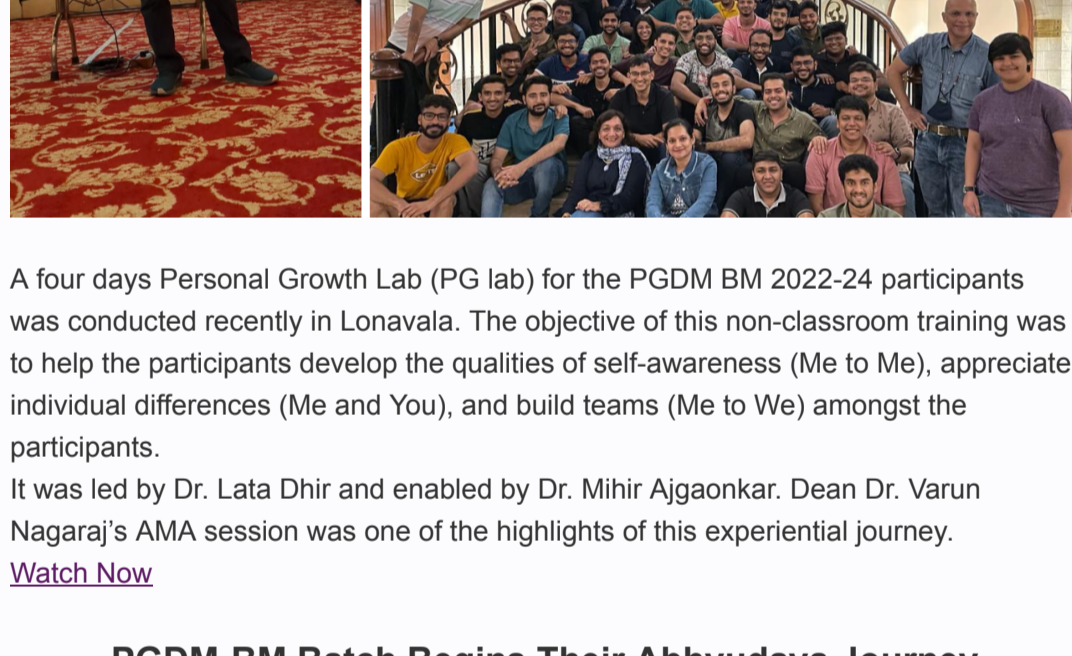
PGEMP Welcomes Batch 88

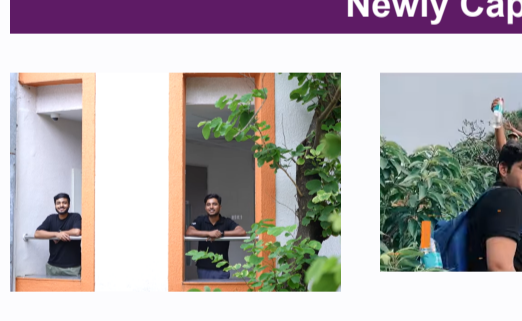

PG Lab For PGDM BM 2022-24



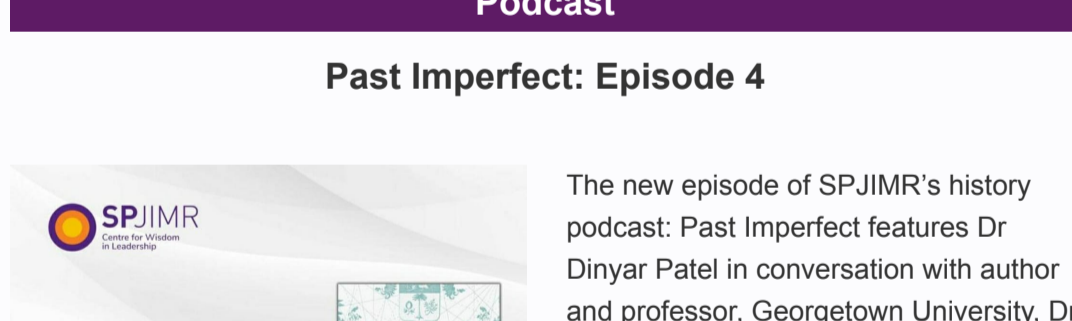

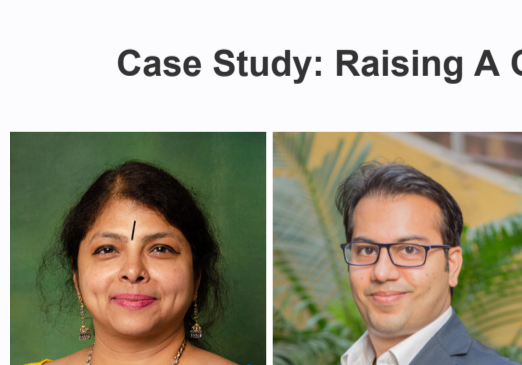
Sapience: Episode 2

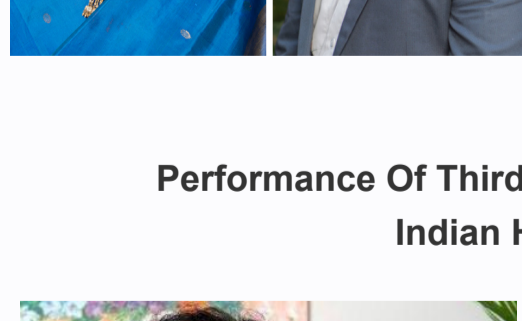

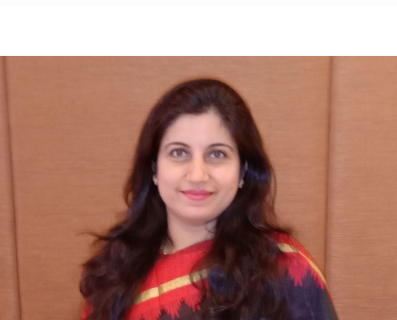
