

⊙ Target Participants

Permanent faculties having a minimum of one year of teaching experience from Centrally Funded Institutes/Universities, State Public Institutes/Universities and Private HEIs.

The selection will be based on the first-cumfirst-serve basis for the eligible participants.

Accommodation will be arranged by SPJIMR in the campus for selected participants.
