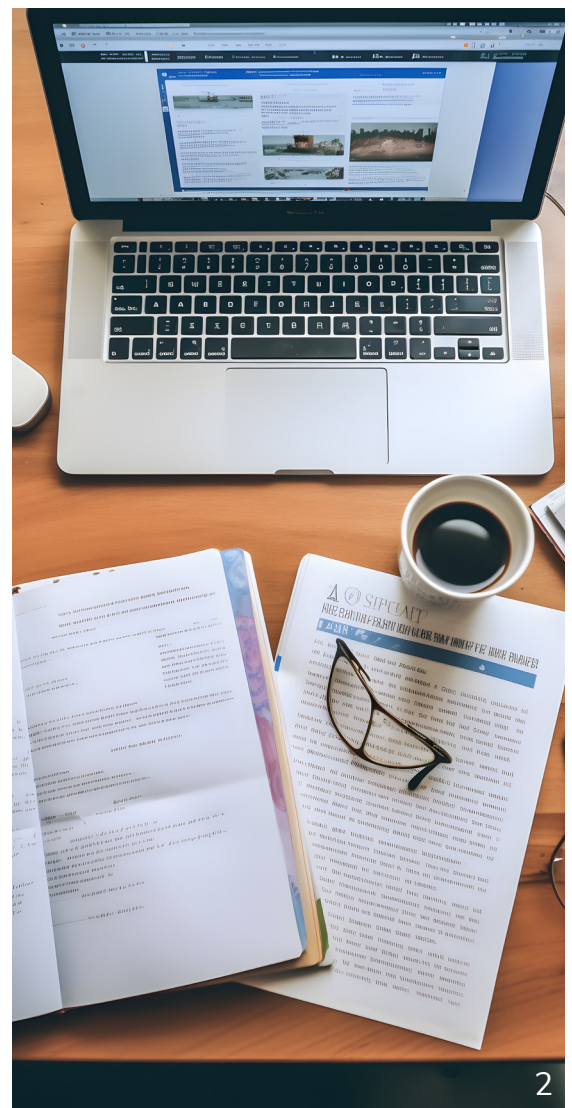
# Advance your research. Strengthen your scholarship. Prepare for publication.

The *Journal of Supply Chain Management (JSCM)* brings its Paper Development Workshop (PDW) 2026 to Mumbai, offering scholars an immersive, in-person opportunity to refine their research for publication in a premier academic journal. Hosted at S.P. Jain Institute of Management and Research (SPJIMR), the workshop enables participants to engage closely with JSCM's editorial leadership and receive guidance on strengthening theoretical contributions, enhancing methodological rigour, and increasing the relevance of their work.

## About the workshop

The JSCM PDW 2026 provides a structured platform for scholars at all career stages to develop high-quality manuscripts. Participants will take part in editorial sessions focused on theory building, disciplinary expansion, research methods, and manuscript development, as well as feedback sessions that offer personalised, written and in-person input from JSCM editors and editorial board members.

This is an **in-person workshop only**, open to PhD students, postdoctoral researchers, and faculty members across institutions.



## How to apply

1. Submit an abstract (maximum 750 words) of your working paper via the [application form](#) by **April 15, 2026**.
2. Abstract acceptance notifications will be shared by **April 30, 2026**.
3. Acceptance of the abstract is a prerequisite for registration. Registration details will be shared with the acceptance email.
4. After acceptance and registration, submit your working paper (max. 10,000 words) by **June 6, 2026**.
5. Participants will receive written feedback ahead of the PDW and will present their work in a 30-minute feedback session during the workshop.
