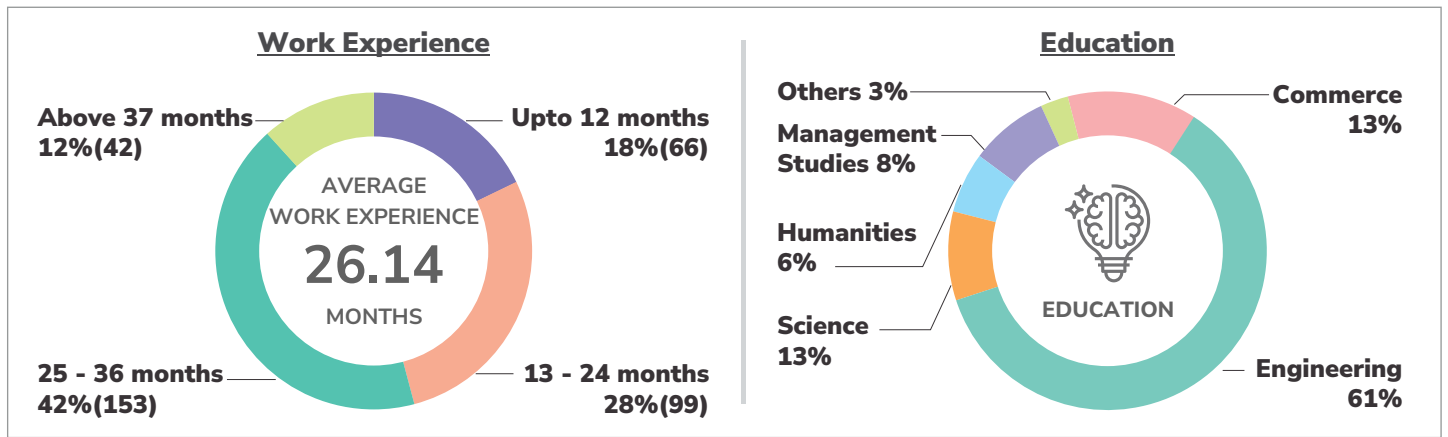

Campus Placement Programme

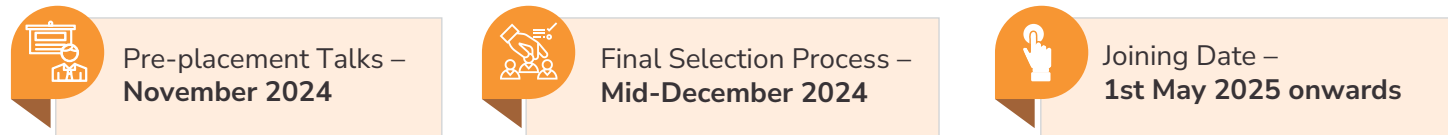
To initiate the selection process, companies will need to post their internship/job requirements and set a pre-placement talk and interview date. The pre-placement talks are scheduled in tandem with the academic calendar. During the PPT, participants look for details on company profile, business line, growth prospects, organisational culture, possible career opportunities, internship project brief, stipend, location, etc. Our students are industry ready, their enthusiasm is contagious, and you will enjoy working with them.

Placement Batches

Summer Internship (Batch 2024-26)

- The Summer Internship is a mandatory credit component of the Post Graduate Diploma in Management (PGDM) course. The participants of Class 2026 with 361 participants, will be available for Summer Internship process (Please refer placement timeline table)
- Pre-Placement Offer (PPO): 40-50% of the batch gets placed through Internships and Corporate competitions route (PPOs), much ahead of the finals process. Students with PPO are signed out from the next hiring cycle

Final Placement (Batch 2023-25)

- Pre-Placement Talk starts 45 days ahead of the Placement Week in the month of November
- Placement week interviews are conducted tentatively in mid-December



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
