## Target Participants

Permanent faculties having a minimum of one year of teaching experience from Centrally Funded Institutes / Universities, State Public Institutes/Universities and Private HEIs.



## Selection

The selection will be based on the first-cum-first-serve basis for the eligible participants.



## Accommodation

Accommodation will be arranged by SPJIMR in the campus for selected participants.



## Registration

**Programme fee is Rs 50,000/- only inclusive of boarding and lodging charges for 5 days, which would be borne by the Ministry of Education (MoE), Govt. of India.**

The participating institutions are responsible for the travel costs of their nominated participants. Additionally, more than two participants from one institute are also welcome, provided the parent institute pays the course fee (Rs 50,000/-) for each additional participant.
